What is a Consumer Confidence Report?

The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) requires community water systems, such as West Central Iowa Rural Water Association, to prepare and make available an annual drinking water quality report to our customers. These reports are called "Consumer Confidence Reports" (CCR). We are pleased to report that our drinking water is safe and meets federal and state requirements. These reports show your water quality and what it means. Drinking water, including bottled drinking water, may be reasonably expected to contain at least small amounts of some contaminants. The presence of these contaminants does not necessarily indicate that water poses a health risk.

Thank you for allowing us to continue providing your family with clean and quality drinking water.

Higher Water Usage Than Normal?

Before making the call to our office, please check a few things around your house and yard. Shut the incoming valve off for a FEW minutes, open the valve slowly, then if you hear a rush of water you have a leak on your system. Look around at your faucets, showers, water heaters and water softeners especially if they are 10 years or older. Check the drain line on your water softener and make sure that it is NOT constantly running a small stream of water, regenerating too much or plugged due to age. Toilets have a high potential to leak and will cause higher water usage. Place food coloring in the back tank of the toilet, wait for about ten minutes, if the color has made it into the bottom bowl, the FLAPPER valve in the back tank is bad and should be replaced. Check outside plumbing. Look in pits to make sure you do not hear or see any water leaking. LISTEN to hydrants. You can hear leaks on them if it is a direct bury hydrant. Also, make sure you are using your physical disconnect properly so you are not pushing water back down your well. When you have exhausted all these options and believe you have a leak, then contact our office.
